At 5 PM, kids can meet Klara and Gaute from KuToppen at the Children's Stage, hosted by Dyreparken (Zoo).

The Guest Harbor will also be buzzing all day with fun and engaging activities for children and youth.

Urban development

Interested in Kristiansand's urban development? Don't miss the event at *Amfibium* on Lagmannsholmen at 1 PM, where artists will offer a creative take on the transformation of the old container port into a vibrant city district. At 4 PM, City Planning Director Venke Moe will present what's next for the area – the biggest transformation in Kristiansand since the city was founded in 1641. That talk takes place at *Krutthuset*, also on Lagmannsholmen.

Closing night with live music and magic moments

We're wrapping up the third and final night of The Tall Ships Races in Kristiansand with music – and it's quite a lineup!

We kick off with ABBA tribute band *Supertrouper* on the Main Stage, followed by *South City Stompers* on the Fjord Line Stage. Then, musical director Bjørn Ole Rasch takes over the Main Stage with a star team of vocalists from Southern Norway.

Half an hour before midnight, *Naked Koala* repeats their stunning mast-top concert stunt on the Sørlandet, before the night ends in style with a midnight concert on top of Odderøya. This evening, Bjøro Hildebrandt and friends promise a magical summer night experience.

And don't forget – all day long, you'll be able to see and photograph the beautiful tall ships taking part in this year's race. Some will also be open to visitors. A total of 48 ships from 16 countries – and around 2,000 young sailors – will be docked around Lagmannsholmen. 150 of the young sailors are from Southern Norway.
